DO NOT BRING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTED ITEMS: Aerosols of any type, hairspray, mouth wash, nail polish, polish remover, razor blades, perfumes, matches, lighters and any sharp items or items containing alcohol. No stereo's, personal CD players, cell phones, I-Pods, laptops, electronic games, DVD's, CD's or cameras. No pop or junk food (chocolate bars, candy, chips etc.)

LUGGAGE IS SEARCHED UPON PROGRAM ENTRY

If restricted items are found or turned in at the program entry the items will be sent home immediately or held until the end of the program.

YOU MAY WISH TO BRING:

- Favorite stuffed animal
- Pictures from home (no glass in frames)
- A cuddly blanket
- Books/ magazine
- Items to help you share your culture

CARE PACKAGES THAT ARE RECEIVED DURING TREATMENT WILL BE SEARCHED AND RESTRICTED ITEMS WILL BE HELD UNTIL THE END OF THE PROGRAM OR SENT HOME

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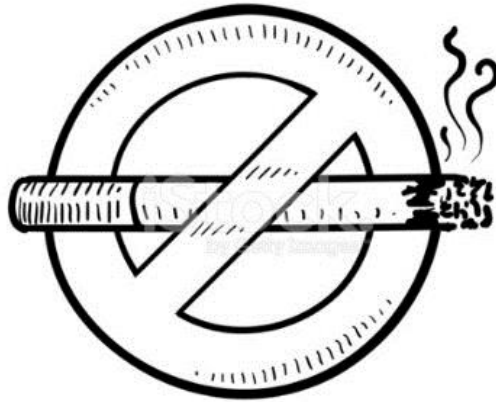
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Smoking Restricted Program

Nenqayni Wellness Center is a non-smoking facility. Smoking is not permitted anywhere on the property by Community Members Served, Staff or Visitors.

Upon Check-in, all tobacco products will be removed and placed in the Members Served restricted bin and will be returned at the time of discharge, if requested.

Smoking cessation plans are strongly recommended prior to arrival and will ensure an easier transition to the Wellness Centre. Empathetic staff will support youth through this transitional time and will provide an educational workshop to review health risks and the harm caused by smoking.
